- Minimum two years of relevant working experience in the field of Disaster Management
- Experience in teaching at College or University level is desirable

- Maintain student attendance records, grades, and other required records.

- Holder of Bachelor Degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences with at least GPA of 3.5. *The applicant should have the above specialization in their degree and not just a university course of Pharmaceutical Sciences*

- Experience in teaching at College or University level is desirable.
